# **Description**

Title: Jason Turner Comic Book Collection

**Biography:** Jason Turner is an artist, cartoonist and Vancouverite who was born in Manitoba in 1970. He is now perhaps best known for his graphic novel *True Loves*, which was published by New Reliable Press in Vancouver in 2006, jointly authored with his wife (and frequent inspiration) Manien Bothma. Beginning in high school with his comic *The Roadhouse Stickler*, Turner has self-published a large collection of comics and drawings, including several lengthy series, that are often inspired by or deal directly with the locations in which he is living or has visited. It is this pervasive sense of awareness and appreciation for his surroundings that runs most often through his work, and this theme was certainly part of the highly favorable reception of *True Loves*, which was nominated for the "One Book, One Vancouver" award in 2007. Turner continues his writing and drawing today, though most of his work has been moved online in recent years.

**Scope and Content:** This collection contains the majority of comic strips, self-published short works and full comic books and series that the author has written to this point. It also contains two graphic novels that were jointly written with Manien Bothma, titled "True Loves," which has gained some prominence and notierity for its depiction of the Vancouver area and was nominated for the "One Book, One Vancouver" award. RBSC also expects to acquire Turner's future comic books.
